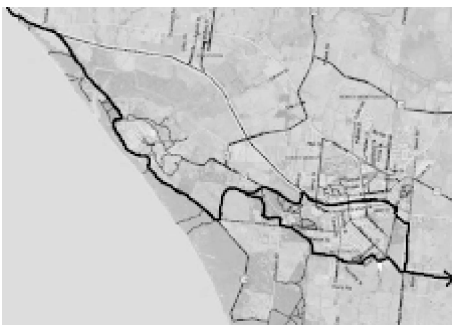
We look forward to further opportunities to be involved in the project. In particular we would welcome the opportunity to be involved in a stakeholder reference group.
